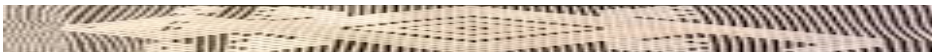

NOTE:

Merchandise Imports excludes values for goods imported for use by foreign Embassies And High Commissions, goods imported for the provision of foreign forces and goods Imported by UN Mission. Imports of goods by these organizations are deemed to be "Non Merchandise Imports".

Exports are goods comprising at least 50 percent Timor-Leste content by value.

Re-Exports are goods for export that were previously imported into Timor-Leste and comprise less than 50 percent Timor-Leste content by value. The external trade register cannot be compared directly with national accounts figures, because the aggregation and Classification, given its own purposes, they are not exactly the same.
